

DESCRIPTION: This plugin allows users to create multiple events and designate instruments for multiple events

VERSION: 1.0

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Define Events:

- 1) Works on multiple arms
- 2) Allows user to define more than one descriptive name/event, using comma separation
- 3) Adds upto 200 events at one time

Define Events does not:

- 1) Allow user to input Days Offset or Offset range (Min/Max)
 - a. Days offset goes in number order. If multiple descriptive names/events are entered they will be given unique days offset
 - b. Offset range (Min/Max) defaults to -0/+0
- 2) Allow user to edit/delete events

Designate Instruments:

- 1) Works on multiple arms
- 2) Removes previous instrument selections if the descriptive name/event is part of your populate criteria
- 3) Gives two options for adding instruments:
 - Add Instruments*
 - a. Allows user to designate the same instruments for more than one descriptive name/event based on a *Start* and *End* pulldown
 - b. Allows user to target a specific descriptive name/event space based on optional *Descriptive name space* pulldown
 - Grid Structure*
 - a. Allows user to designate the same instruments for more than one event based on the *Same instrument as* pull-down

Set-up project bookmark:

- 1) Link label will be specific to project
- 2) Link URL always: https://redcap.ucdenver.edu/rcplugins/multi/define_multi_events.php
- 3) Link Type always: Simple Link
- 4) User Access will be specific to project
- 5) Append project ID to URL: always

Set up project bookmarks

This module will allow you to set up project bookmarks (i.e. custom links) that point to webpages that exist inside REDCap (i.e. other REDCap projects) or outside REDCap (i.e. webpages on a different server on the web). You can create simple web links for navigating to those webpages, and the links will be displayed on the left-hand project menu. You may set various settings for each link, such as defining the label for how it appears on the left-hand menu, whether or not the link opens a new window/tab in your web browser, and which individual users (or Data Access Groups) within your project will be able to utilize these bookmarks.

You may [add a new bookmark](#) at the bottom of this page. You simply need to provide a label and a web address (URL). If you want to merely take the user to the target website, using the Simple Link option should be enough. You can create links to other REDCap projects that you have access to by selecting the REDCap Project link type. It will bring up a list of your projects, after which you will be able to choose one to create the link to it. Linking to other REDCap projects can be useful if several projects are related and require users to navigate back and forth between them often. You may also utilize more advanced capabilities if you use the Advanced Link option, which additionally sends extra information (e.g., user and project info) from REDCap to the target website as a means of verifying the identity of the REDCap user on that external site.
